Remember to license your pet. All pet licensing will be taken care of by the Sheboygan Police Dept. All animal licenses will be sold at the front desk of the Sheboygan Police Dept. at 1315 N 23rd St. Animal licenses will no longer be sold at the City of Sheboygan Finance Department. If you adopt an animal from the shelter, you will receive your initial license from SCHS during your adoption.



Fun Animal Facts:

- Dogs' noses secrete a thin layer of mucous that helps them absorb scent. They then lick their noses to sample the scent through their mouth.
- A Dog's sense of smell is 10,000 – 100,000 times more acute as that of humans.
- It's a myth that dogs only see in black and white. In fact, it's believed that dogs see primarily in blue, greenish-yellow, yellow and various shades of gray.
- Dogs curl up in a ball when they sleep due to an age-old instinct to keep themselves warm and protect their abdomen and vital organs from predators.
- Unlike dogs, cats cannot taste food that is sweet
- A cat's hearing is better than a dog's. And a cat can hear high-frequency sounds up to two octaves higher than a human.

Occasionally we get positive cats and would love to place them in a home if we know there is one available. Cats that are positive for either would not be suitable in homes where a cat is not positive. They are only suitable for homes without cats or with cats that are already positive.

Have a large farm or a hobby farm? We occasionally get feral cats that can't be placed in homes but would make a perfect addition to your outdoor cat colony.
